



REQUEST FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SERVE ON SAQA'S PROFESSIONAL BODIES COMMITTEE

SAQA invites applications from individuals meeting the criteria for appointment to its Professional Bodies Committee for the period 1 January 2022 – 31 December 2025.

The Professional Bodies Committee is a sub-committee of the SAQA Board, formed in terms of Section 16 of the National Qualification Framework Act 67 of 2008, as amended.

Purpose

The SAQA Professional Bodies Committee is responsible for ensuring that the SAQA *Policy and Criteria for Recognising a Professional Body and Registering a Professional Designation for the Purposes of the National Qualifications Framework Act, No. 67 of 2008 (hereinafter referred to as the Policy and Criteria)*, is aligned to SAQA's mandate and current strategy and for overseeing the recognition of professional bodies and the registration of professional designations in alignment with the *Policy and Criteria*.

Criteria for Appointment

Individuals should have at least three (3) years of experience working for professional bodies at a strategic level and have been involved in the development and implementation of policies and procedures and are exposed to career pathways and competency frameworks. Knowledge of applying SAQA's *Policy and Criteria for Recognising a Professional Body and Registering a Professional Designation for the Purposes of the National Qualifications Framework Act, Act 67 of 2008 (As amended, September 2020)* is essential.

Meeting fees are paid according to National Treasury Guidelines.

Interested individuals may submit their CVs as well as copies of their Identity Documents (ID) and qualifications to the SAQA Secretariat (sagasecretariat@saqa.org.za) on or before 8 October 2021.

Kindly note that SAQA will verify the qualifications and professional designations of successful candidates before the appointment.
