



REQUEST FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SERVE ON SAQA'S NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK (NQF) QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE

SAQA invites applications from individuals meeting the criteria for appointment to its NQF Qualifications Committee for the period 1 April 2022 – 31 December 2025.

The NQF Qualifications Committee is a sub-committee of the SAQA Board, formed in terms of Section 16 of the National Qualification Framework Act 67 of 2008, as amended.

Purpose

The SAQA NQF Qualifications Committee is responsible for ensuring that SAQA's *Policy and Criteria for the Registration of Qualifications and Part-Qualifications on the NQF (As amended, 2020)*, hereinafter known as the *Policy and Criteria* are aligned to SAQA's mandate and current strategy and for overseeing the registration of qualifications and part-qualifications on the NQF in alignment with the *Policy and Criteria*.

Criteria for Appointment

Individuals should have at least five (5) years of relevant experience in designing, evaluating or accrediting qualifications on any of the three NQF Sub-Frameworks. Knowledge of applying the South African Level Descriptors and SAQA's *Policy and Criteria for the Registration of Qualifications and Part-Qualifications on the NQF (As amended, 2020)* is essential.

Meeting fees are paid according to National Treasury Guidelines.

Interested individuals may submit their CVs as well as copies of their Identity Documents (ID) and qualifications to the SAQA Secretariat (saqasecretariat@saqa.org.za) on or before 31 January 2022.

Kindly note that SAQA will verify the qualifications and professional designations of successful candidates before appointment.
